## **FIBA Europe Video Analysis Course (FEVAC)**

We are pleased to announce the launch of a new educational initiative by FIBA Europe.

# **FIBA Europe Video Analysis Course**

This course targets coaches from the national teams as well as from the professional leagues with advanced basketball knowledge. It is designed to enhance their skills in utilizing video as an effective teaching tool at both youth and senior levels.

The course will comprehensively cover the theoretical, practical, pedagogical and psychological aspects of video analysis in coaching.

Participants will benefit from the expertise of professionals with diverse backgrounds, ensuring a well-rounded and in-depth understanding of the subject matter.

Upon successful completion, participants will receive an official confirmation of participation.

### **Course Schedule**

- ✓ The program consists of 12 sessions
- ✓ They will be delivered in 6 online evening sessions, each lasting 2 x 75 min.
- ✓ Sessions will take place in the evenings starting at the end of August until end of September 2026.

### **Participation Requirements**

- ✓ Participants must have a high level of basketball knowledge and be fluent in English

**Participation fee:** 50,- EUR per coach

Requirement to receive the confirmation is attending min. 10 out of the 12 sessions.

## **Experts:**

### **Mario Fioretti**

Head Coach Derthona Basket, Italy 1st Division. In the last 22 years he has worked for Olimpia Milano as assistant coach, while also serving as assistant coach for the Italian National Team from 2011 to 2017. He's considered to be Italy's foremost expert in video analysis and opponent scouting.

### **Martin Schiller**

Assistant Coach University of Utah, NCAA. He has served as head coach in four different countries, including Zalgiris Kaunas in the EuroLeague and Casademont Zaragoza in Spain's Liga ACB. Named NBA G League Coach of the Year in 2020 with Salt Lake City Stars, he also served as assistant coach for the German National Team from 2015 to 2019, working alongside NBA stars such as Dirk Nowitzki and Dennis Schröder. Big time experience with youth and senior level.

### **Francesco Olivo**

Head of Scouting Virtus Bologna. He joined the Italian team as a data analyst in 2022/23, progressively taking on greater responsibilities, covering scouting and analytics. He also serves as Advanced Stats and Video Analyst for the French National Basketball Team. A pioneer in the use of advanced AI and data science applied to basketball.

### **Aysim Altay**

Turkish mental coach with a background in Computer Engineering, trained in a wide range of disciplines including NLP, Cognitive Behavioral Therapy, Milton Erickson Hypnosis, and Gestalt Therapy, among others, which she applies as complementary tools in her work with athletes and teams. A leading expert of the FIBA Europe Coaching Certificate (FECC) program, she is a regular lecturer at FIBA Europe's top coaching education events, having also advised sports teams and clubs on increasing athlete motivation and maximizing their potential.

### **Sergio Lara-Bercial**

Spanish-born Professor of Sport Coaching at Leeds Beckett University and Vice President for Strategy and Development at the International Council for Coaching Excellence, he is a former international basketball coach for Great Britain who has coached for over 25 years and won 19 national titles with both male and female teams. Co-founder of ICOACHKIDS — a global movement helping coaches put kids first in sport — he has published widely on coaching-related topics and delivered keynotes and workshops across five continents, consulting for organisations such as Nike, FIFA, UEFA, FIBA, and the IOC.

### **Nick Marzoli**

Head of the Information Technology Department at FIBA Europe, he has been involved in high-level organizational and technical projects across the continent, including the inspection and planning of major international arena infrastructure for events such as EuroBasket. A key contributor to the development of global basketball data standards, he was among the experts who collaborated on the official FIBA Statisticians' Manual, setting the statistical criteria followed by statisticians worldwide
